



The Patricius winery was established in 2000 by the Kékessy family in the Tokaj region of Hungary. The Kékessy family's winemaking mission is nurtured by their rich family history—both the family's maternal and paternal ancestors were well-known vineyard owners in the regions of the Tokaj and the Mátra foothills from the 18th century. Patricius produces a Tokaji Aszú, the Hungarian elixir steeped in lore, however they are on the cutting edge of Hungarian winemaking producing a full line-up of dry wines including: Furmint, Hárslevelü, and Yellow Muscat.

- 100% Hárslevelü
- Sourced from Grand Cru classified estate vineyards with volcanic, mineral rich soils.
- Fermented and aged in temperature controlled stainless steel tanks.
- Alcohol: 12.5%
- Residual Sugar: 0.5 g/L
- Acidity: 5.8 g/L

Tasting Note: Honey and fruitiness, elegant minerality and nice balance characterizes this terroir-wine.
